



THE KRUGER & CANYONS TOUR

This 5-day tour combines nature and scenery with time to relax in the picturesque Lowveld. Enjoy an open vehicle safari in the Kruger Park, marvel at the wonders of the Panorama Route or learn rehabilitation techniques at Moholoholo! With a professional, qualified guide to escort you all the way, all you have to do is sit back & unwind and Rissington Inn is the perfect place to do that!

DAY 1: On arrival at Nelspruit/Kruger Mpumalanga Airport you will be met by African Safari Adventures and transferred to Rissington Inn where you will be accommodated for 4 nights on a dinner, bed & breakfast basis in one of their superior rooms (mini-suite). Set in indigenous bush just outside Hazyview, Rissington Inn provides fine hospitality in a relaxed and informal environment. The thatched homestead has long views over the Sabie River Valley and offers individually furnished bedrooms, extensive gardens, spectacular birdlife, a sparkling pool and sundowners on the veranda. Delicious, imaginative cuisine in the à la carte restaurant

DAY 2: After breakfast, depart for a full day Panorama Tour, starting at 09h00. Visit the Blyde River Canyon – the world’s third largest - to view stunning rock formations and view sites, such as God’s Window, Lisbon Falls, Bourke’s Luck Potholes and The Three Rondavels. After lunch (own account) we visit one of the pretty waterfalls, such as Lone Creek or Bridal Veil Falls, on the outskirts of the forestry town of Sabie. Arrive back at Rissington in the late afternoon to relax and enjoy sundowners (own account) before dinner

DAY 3: Depart Rissington at 05h00 for a full day open vehicle safari in the Kruger National Park (breakfast picnics will be supplied). The Kruger is home to the Big Five – lion, elephant, rhino, buffalo and leopard – and a huge variety of birds, reptiles and other mammals. Stop for lunch (own account) at around 12h30 at one of the Parks’ rest camps followed by an afternoon of game-viewing. Arrive back at the lodge at around 16h00. Dinner in the restaurant

DAY 4: Depart Rissington at around 09h00 and travel north towards Hoedspruit to the Blyde River Canyon for an alternative look at the Blyde Dam. We board the boat for an interpretive tour with a qualified site guide who will show you the rare, living Kadishi Tufa waterfall, which at 200m (660 feet) is the 2nd tallest Tufa waterfall on earth. An abundance of wildlife, including hippos, crocodiles, primates and a diversity of birdlife, will keep you enthralled while learning more about the natural history of the Blyde Canyon. The cruise takes about 1.5hrs and is followed by lunch (own account) before we head to Moholoholo Rehabilitation Centre for their tour at 15h00. Their experts will take you around the centre where some of the animals and birds might be handled depending on their condition. Learn about the rehabilitation techniques and treatment of injured, poisoned and abandoned animals & birds of prey. Depart Moholoholo at around 16h30 for the journey back to Hazyview arriving at around 18h00. Dinner in the restaurant

DAY 5: Transfer back to the airport for your onward flight
